The Manager Privacy and Freedom of Information (FOI) will be accountable for developing and implementing a comprehensive Privacy Strategy that manages risk effectively throughout the company. This position is also responsible for ensuring that all business processes and procedures are compliant with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA) and meet or exceed generally accepted standards for privacy protection.

The position develops privacy strategies and sets broad goals and practices for the corporation on meeting the public's expectation on the collection, use, disclosure and protection of personal information, as well as manages the responses to a high volume of FOI requests.

Position Requirements:

Demonstrated experience and knowledge should include extensive knowledge of FOI and privacy principles, and familiarity with codes such as Generally Accepted Privacy Principles (GAPP) and the CSA model code for protection of personal information. The successful candidate will have a thorough understanding of the BC Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act; also, knowledge of privacy and FOI case-law and history of decisions and public statements made by the BC information and Privacy Commissioner.

Knowledge of the insurance industry, including principles and practices, relevant acts, regulations and guidelines would be beneficial.

This position requires someone with strong people and business leadership skills including the knowledge and experience in providing leadership and guidance to their own professional staff, and influencing senior leaders and business areas across the organization.

A university degree in Business or Public Administration and/or Law or equivalent is required. The Certified Information Privacy Professional – Canada (CIPP/C) designation would be desirable.
